- **Energy - Carbon Zero by 2030, energy audit**
- **Water - Reduce water consumption 50% by 2030**
- **Waste - 85% solid waste reduction by 2030**
- **Materials - paper and recycled building materials**
- **Grounds - “Grey to Green”**
- **Food Service - Reduce Food Insecurity and Serve Community**
